Movie stars and other famous people frequently use veneers to achieve their stunning smiles due to veneers being minimally invasive, painless, and overall a healthier alternative to other procedures.



We have all heard of dental veneers, but have you ever wondered exactly what they are, and how they work? Essentially, veneers are wafer thin pieces of either porcelain or ceramic material that are bonded to the front of your teeth to create the picture perfect look.

TOP 5 Misconceptions About Dental Veneers



Here's a list of the top 5 misconceptions we've heard from patients. It's important to make sure you have all your facts straight.

- 1. Dental Veneers Are Painful.** The procedure to get dental veneers is minimally invasive, and most people who have dental veneers report feeling absolutely no pain or discomfort at all during the procedure. Most dentists use some type of numbing agent for the first part of the process, and the only preparation for veneers is the removal of a very thin layer of the tooth. This layer is equal in thickness to the veneer itself. This is done to ensure a good fit, and should not cause pain.
- 2. Veneers Are Only For Front Teeth.** While veneers do sometimes help with functionality, they are mostly cosmetic. Because of this, any teeth that are highly visible are candidates for dental veneers. In order to cover your full smile, you would need about eight veneers to cover the area that is visible when you smile or talk.
- 3. Veneers Are Only Used for Cosmetic Purposes.** While dental veneers are mainly used for cosmetic purposes, getting them can absolutely improve your teeth's functionality as well! They do this by fixing gaps, worn down teeth, or teeth with enamel erosion or abrasion. While many people think that dental veneers are only cosmetic, many of the things that they fix cosmetically also happen to improve functionality.
- 4. Veneers Have an Unnatural Appearance.** When you have a good dentist such as Dr. Stuart Shlosberg, who uses the proper materials and has many years of experience, your veneers will NOT have an unnatural appearance at all. In fact, -veneers -applied properly, look completely unnoticeable.
- 5. Veneers Break Easily.** Veneers are very hard and durable. However, just how durable they are will depend largely on the materials used. Generally speaking, if you are mindful of your veneers and take good care of them, they can last for a long time.
